The Flatlanders will provide a free BBQ dinner with all the fixin’s. Tea will be provided, otherwise it’s BYOB

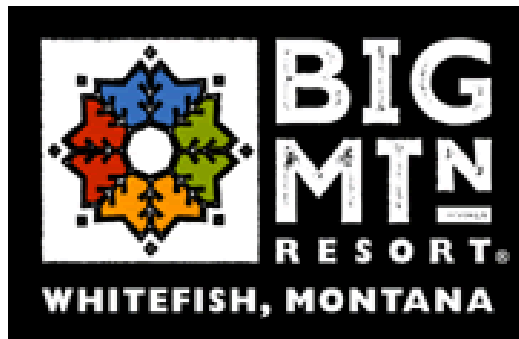

Just an hour west of Denver and outside of Dillon is the resort of Keystone. Keystone is home to many of the TSC fall trips with the snowmaking to help guarantee a wonderful Thanksgiving trip. **The trip will include five nights lodging in a 2 bed / 2 bath condo and four days of lift tickets. The price per adult is \$495.** This price is just \$20 more than we paid in 2003. This year we will be staying in lodging within walking distance to the lift — no bus ride. The pricing for children is the real attraction this year. Kids will get a special 4 day ski school price that includes equipment rental, all day lessons, lift tickets, lunch and fun evening activities (a \$502 value!). Vail Resorts in partnership with the TSC is pricing this package at \$152 for the entire four days! Since kids stay free in your condo that means **a child can attend for just \$182 including ski school.** This pricing is for packages age 12 and under. There is also some very good pricing for more advanced classes and older participants.

\$50 deposit due now—balance by October 18th—
last day to cancel without penalty is September 22nd.
